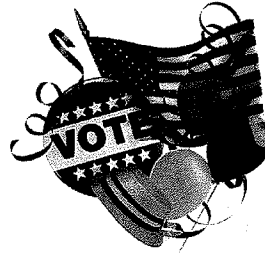


New Year Resolution:

Election Officers Needed! We provide training and participants receive a stipends of \$20-\$30 for attending training class and \$40 -\$100 for serving depending on their assignment.

We offer a unique opportunity for high school students and service organizations to participate and make a difference in their community:

Youth with a Vision Election Officer Program- allows high school students to be part of the election process and show that young people can make a positive difference in their local community while providing a civic service. Participants must be 16 years old, U.S. Citizens, have a 2.5 GPA (on a 4.0 scale), and have parent's permission and teacher recommendation. Each student will receive a monetary stipend based on the position assigned.

Adopt-A-Poll Program- members of service clubs and non-profit organizations can serve at the polls and fund-raise money for their organization while serving their community. Participants must be registered voters in California and be able to read, write and speak English.
